Floods Relief Work – Report for 11 August 2010

Dear friends,

as salamu alaykum

We had a meeting with the Abdalian Association today as a part of our on-going joint efforts similar to what we did after the earthquake in 2005 and the Swat IDP relief last year. We intend to continue this joint effort for the relief and rehabilitation of the floods victims as well insha Allah.

We had a long discussion on what are the areas that we would like to participate in due to limitations of our financial and manpower resources. In order to be more effective, we have decided to focus on two or three specific projects. And if we can raise a lot more funds, then insha Allah we will take on even more.

Following are the few points that we agreed on:

1. There are many NGOs and individuals who are rushing to the affected areas to provide food and other relief items. This is a great effort which should continue. However, since so many others are doing it, we thought that it would be better to concentrate on rehabilitation activities as the floods waters start receding. People have lost their homes and belongings and they need rehabilitation badly.
2. We also decided not to join hands with any of the large NGOs who have very high overhead costs, and we are aware that only a relatively small fraction of money actually goes into relief and rehabilitation. We experienced this at both of the previous disasters, where the other NGOs spent between 20-60% of the funds only for their own overheads. As against that, the Petarian-Abdalian overheads were negligible and we were able to benefit the people directly with almost all of the funds. We do not have management salaries and perks and large SUVs, etc. We work directly with the affected people.
3. We will be selecting specific villages / towns for rehabilitation work, just like we did in the previous cases. We do not want to just go all over the place to dump relief goods. This will have a clear mandate.
4. Some of the Abdalians / Petarians have their own road making and construction machinery and companies. They will be using this machinery and manpower (free of cost) to build some roads and try to rebuild homes.
5. We are going to acquire some second hand machinery to build low cost building blocks. These are machines that produce high strength blocks and are interlocking type. The blocks produced will be given free of cost to those who lost their homes so that they may rebuild them. The affected people will use their own labour but the material will be provided by us.

- the Abdalians will take a lead in the work to be done in KP and Punjab
- the Petarians will take a lead in the work to be done in Sindh.

We will need

- Volunteers
- Funds
- Donations in kind - like machines, material, etc.

Brig Mukhtar will be discussing this in more detail with the MC of TPA and will revert to me on the modalities of how to go about the whole matter insha Allah.

I would like to appeal to all Petarians to come forward to join hands in this effort to participate in the alleviation of misery of those affected by this huge calamity.
